

To begin, make sure the vehicle is in park and on level ground

Step 1: Locate and remove the 2x screws, using a 4mm Allen wrench, that holds down the ignition key cover (circled).



Step 2: Locate the wire that connects to the front headlight (circled) and unplug it.



Step 3: Loosen the 2x screws, using a 5mm Allen wrench, holding the top handlebar clamp (circled).




Step 4: Locate and remove 4x screws, using a 4mm Allen wrench, holding the OEM headlight bracket. Adjust handlebars left or right to make access to the screws easier. Remove OEM headlight.





Step 5: Assemble Baja Designs light according to included parts bag instructions. Make sure the headlight bolt (circled) is through the light's mounting bracket to ease installation.



Step 6: Attach Baja Designs light to the included headlight bracket using either 2x 9/16" wrenches (Squadron or S2) or 2x 7/16" wrenches (S1). Ensure the new bracket tab is facing down (circled) while the Baja Designs light is in the upright orientation.



\*Baja Designs light is in upright orientation\*


Step 7: Attach the newly assembled Baja Designs light and bracket using the 4x original bike screws from Step 4.




Step 8: Re-tighten handlebar screws, using the 5mm Allen wrench, making sure the handlebars are straight.



Step 9: Plug the Baja Designs light into the included harness, then into the factory bike harness.

Step 11: Attach on/off switch to the left side of the handlebar using 8mm and 10mm wrenches. Route all cables with existing bike wiring.







Step 12: Route all cables back underneath the bike's ignition switch housing (boxed) and resecure using the 2x screws from Step 1 (circled). Leave ample room when routing cables so that nothing is stretched when handlebars are at full lock in either direction.



Step 13: Test the Baja Designs light and confirm it is fully functional and no loose connections exist.



Step 14: Adjust the Baja Designs light pitch by loosening/tightening the 2x screws holding the light to the silver bracket.



<sup>\*</sup>Tie all wires away from sharp, hot, and/or rotating components.

<sup>\*</sup> Re-torque all the fasteners after 100 miles.
